2010 Survey HBCUs, AA Study Programs

N = 99 institutions; 28% response rate

Q: Courses or programs for AAHx Mo or MLK, Jr Day?

50% - no courses, no programming

**25% - special programming alone, e.g.
speaker, lectures, community event**

11% - courses alone

14% - courses and special programming



2010 Survey HBCUs, AA Study Programs

Q: What would be useful in offering courses or programming?

75% - comprehensive guide on educational materials

54% - assistance in using such a guide

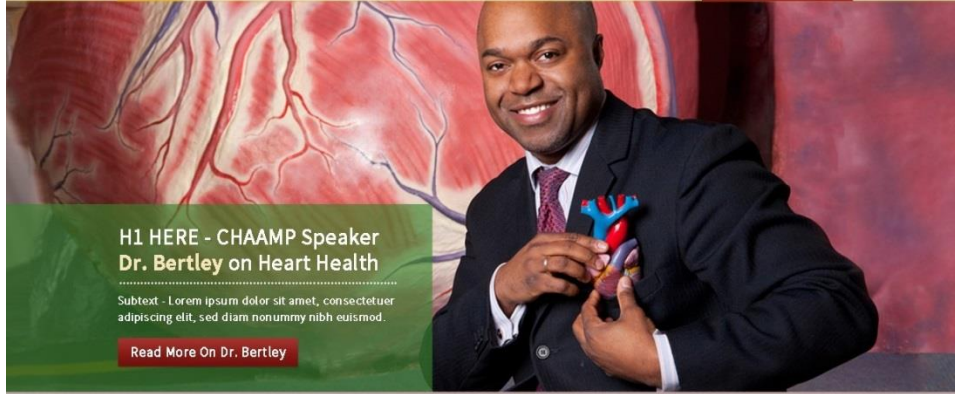
61% - sample reading list
